Work Screen Updates

- Look ahead independent adjustments
- Change the auto shutoff mode on the run

Auto shutoff button (tap on the run)

Shutoff = don't overlap
Overlap = continous coverage

Look ahead points

Green dot = Coverage turn on
Red dot = Coverage turn off

Tap here to adjust overlap



- The blue coverage will be delayed


Preset rate screen

- Shows if you already have some rates entered
- Example has 3 rates entered: 80kg/ha and 100kg/ha and 120kg/ha




Variable rate maps

- Clutter removed from list (holding, attribs etc)



Product calibration sample

- Shows maximum limit (instead of rolling over to negative number)



Android System Update

- DO NOT update the tablet (major system update)
- This can cause wifi problems
- Just install the new spreader app shown below

How To Get The New App

- Delete your spreader app
- You will lose coverage maps and variable rate maps
- You will NOT lose calibrations and settings (they're stored on the machine)
- Connect tablet to internet
- Google i4m
- Tap Support > Spreader > i4M-Version2 > Download-App > Select the bottom file
- Tap Open (or go to downloads folder and tap the file)
- Tap Install
- "Unsafe app blocked message" Tap More > Tap Install anyway
- Done
